
VERMONT'S BUILDING ENERGY CODES

Vermont's Building Energy Codes — the Vermont Residential Building Energy Standards (VT-RBES) and Vermont Commercial Building Energy Standards (VT-CBES) — are <u>minimum</u> standards of energy efficiency that apply to all new residential construction, renovations, alterations, and repairs in Vermont.

Beginning July 1, 2013- a completed and signed Energy Code Certificate MUST be recorded with the Underhill Town Clerk before a Certificate of Occupancy can be issued by the Zoning Administrator.
