The purpose of this request is to make improvements to the Underhill Central School playground and outdoor learning spaces.

The requested funding would pay for a ramped playground structure, free standing playground equipment, exercise stations and sun shades for outdoor classrooms.

## **Attachment A: Underhill Central School Playground Project Overview**

The Underhill Central School (UCS) playground is a critical part of day to day life at UCS. The playground is used daily for recess, movement breaks, after school programs, and by the Underhill community.

### **Existing Conditions:**

While the existing playground offers lots of fun, it also provides many opportunities for improvement. The existing large play structure is 22 years old which is within the manufacturer's recommended 20-25 year useful life. The equipment is structurally sound and safe for continued use but is starting to show its age in delaminating surfaces and rusting metal components. Additionally, the structure is not accessible for children with different abilities. Due to the numbers of students and uses throughout the day, the playground is limited in the number of children that can safely use the space at one time.

UCS teachers and staff have always had an appreciation for outdoor learning. The COVID pandemic has only increased the desire to spend more time outside. However, limited seating, equipment, and shaded areas makes outdoor classroom time hard to achieve at times.

### **Planned improvements:**

The new playground equipment will enhance this school and community resource. It will increase the variety and quantity of equipment available. Included equipment will address accessibility and inclusivity concerns. (Please note, equipment included in the Miracle Recreation proposal are only recommendations for cost estimating. If this project is approved to move forward, we intend to solicit feedback from the school and community to help in making final equipment selections.)

- Large playground structure – the new structure will include features similar to what is existing with a variety of slides and climbing features. In addition, the new playground will encourage inclusive play through access ramps, interactive panels and accessible components.
- Freestanding equipment – to enhance the overall playground environment, additional freestanding equipment will be added to provide a greater variety of equipment. This equipment encourages cooperative play but in a less busy environment than the large structure. Accessibility concerns that would be addressed through a new, raised sandbox.
- Exercise equipment - Simple exercise stations that can be spread throughout the school grounds, will be installed for use in physical education classes and by the greater Underhill community. We are aware of another proposal to the ARPA committee to enhance biking and walking trails around UCS. If that project moves forward, our plan would be to coordinate the exercise equipment installation locations with the new path.
- Sun shades and outdoor classroom equipment – outdoor learning is a priority for the teachers and staff at UCS. However, weather conditions sometimes limit the feasibility

of this learning environment. We propose to install sun shades to create learning spaces that are more useful in the early fall and late spring time periods. We would also purchase some of the seating and teaching equipment (easels, carts for transporting materials) staff need to make outdoor learning practical.

The equipment included in this request would revamp the entire playground. Other than some recently installed equipment, much of the playground equipment will be replaced. As much as we'd love to see this full project move forward, we realize it may exceed the funding available and/or the priorities of the ARPA committee/select board. There are many ways that this proposal can be refined to reduce the total cost while still making important improvements to this playground. We would be happy to work with the committee to tailor this work to best fit the goals of the town. We also plan to work within our school community to bring together teams of volunteers to help with the playground installation. Not only will this be a community building activity, it will also save on some of the installation costs.

Thank you for considering this request. We look forward to discussing this project with you further.
