- (a) A written petition, signed by not less than 15 percent of the registered voters of the Town, seeking the removal of such Town officer or officers, and requesting a vote of the Town at a regular or special town meeting called for the purpose, shall be filed with the Selectboard and the town clerk.
- (b) The Selectboard shall call a special Town meeting, to be held within 45 days of receiving the petition, to vote by Australian ballot on whether the elected officer shall be removed.
- (c) If such a petition is approved by a majority of the ballots cast at said special Town meeting, the Town officer named in the petition shall thereupon cease to hold his or her office and the office shall become vacant.
- (d) A vacancy resulting from the recall of an officer shall be filled in the manner prescribed by law.
- (e) A recall petition shall not be brought against an individual more than once within 12 months.
