

**TOWN OF UNDERHILL
SELECTBOARD SITE VISIT MINUTES
Thursday, April 19, 2011**

Present: Dan Steinbauer – Chair, Steve Owen – Selectperson, Brad Holden – Selectperson, Faith Brown – Interim Administrator, Rod Fuller – Road Foreman, and town residents

5:00 PM Site Visit begins on Stevensville Road:

Rod Fuller explains the road work he plans to do this summer on the section of Stevensville Road from the corner of Maple Leaf Road to the top of the first hill. A Better Back Roads grant was approved to do this work. Drainage needs to be improved along that section to ensure proper drainage further down the road. Town right-of-ways were discussed as well as possible sites for culverts. Maps and survey information was shared by Brad Holden. Rod will contact adjacent landowners and will share the resulting plan with interested residents. An email list will be put together for this purpose.

6:00 PM Site Visit begins at the end of Beartown Road:

The Selectboard, Interim Administrator and the Road Foreman then go to the end of Beartown Road to talk with the McKnights about their snowplowing concern. Brad shares warranty deeds and surveys of the area that shows the town owns the land the road occupies. Some of the land the town owns is currently being maintained as private property. Rod requests that the McKnights move the stones to the right of their driveway that are on town land so that snow can be piled in that area. The McKnights agree to be back in touch with Rod.
