Minutes of the August 16th meeting were approved.

Doggie bags were discussed again. Kiosks should tell dog owners to bring their own containers and pick up after their pets rather than our trying to keep a supply of bags available.

Pat will send the material's list to Curtis Lumber and Parker and Stearns to see if they can donate some materials. Pat will check with Kari to see if in hearing we said no pressure treated. Application states hemlock or cedar will be used for a more natural look.

If all the post locations were marked, we could rent a two-man gas powered post hole digger for a day and dig all the holes. Jeri-Hill may have one; Essex Rent-All does for sure. Due to hunting season, we will probably have to wait until December to start.

The DRB has referred us to the Select Board for permission to place a kiosk and parking within the New Road right-of-way. Carol will contact Linda to request that they put us on their agenda.

We reviewed Carol's article on "Trail Bridges and Structures" and made a few changes to emphasize that permission and permits are required. That and the one Nancy assembled on Vermont Trail Ethics will be submitted to the Selectboard for approval and then on to the Mountain Gazette.
